Ken Stiles was named co-CEO of Stiles, the Fort Lauderdale-based full service real estate firm.

Stiles, previously executive vice president, will lead the company with chairman and CEO Terry Stiles, according to a press release. At the same time, **Scott MacLaren** was promoted to president of the firm, succeeding Doug Eagon. Ken Stiles joined the company 11 years ago, while MacLaren joined 17 years ago.

MacLaren's predecessor is now vice chair of Stiles, where he will work with the board and MacLaren on the firm's long-term strategy. The [changes in leadership](#) were announced last April. Stiles is a Fort Lauderdale-based full service real estate development firm that was established in 1951.
